

GRENFELL AND TRUNK K CASE STUDY

Central Tablelands Water - Gooloogong to Grenfell Trunk Main K Pipeline Project

Cadia was proud to win the initial stage of the tender for the supply of pipe and fittings to the Grenfell Pipeline project 'Stage 1', listed by CTW late 2016. Cadia successfully supplied over 13km of modified PVC to replace the cast iron pipeline that had been installed in 1946.

Cadia's customer focused offer, comprising of price competitiveness and the ability to provide both technical advice and flexibility, are what ultimately saw it win the tender. Goods were supplied on schedule and to specifications, and the client, CTW, was happy to maintain Cadia as the preferred supplier of further 10km of modified PVC for the following Stage 2 section of the project.

In 2019, Cadia's proven performance on the previous two Stages, has again saw them secure further work for the final Trunk Main K Stage 3 augmentation, this time for an order of 14km (with an additional 3km option) of Ductile Iron Cement Lined pipe and fittings to complete the Gooloogong to Grenfell project in its entirety.

This pipeline will provide an ongoing and reliable supply of fresh drinking water to the Grenfell township and their rural connections within the Weddin Shire.
